
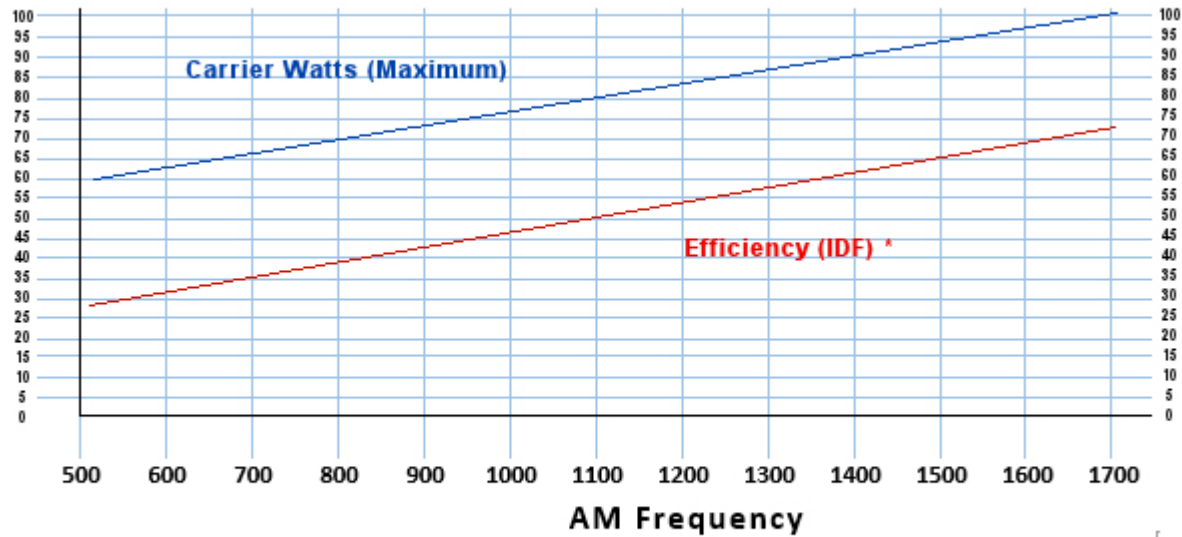

Description	Our ANXX Antenna may be mounted atop a square or round pole of wood, metal or fiberglass. It can operate in conjunction with the Vertical Profile Antenna Support & Grounding System (VP.9000). It may also be building-installed on a flat roof using a ballasted stand with groundplane.

See chart below. • Lateral separation from taller structures required for full range. • Bandwidth (3:1 SWR): 530 kHz: 5 kHz; 1710 kHz: 10.4 kHz. • Temperature endurance: -40°C. to 85°C. • Wind endurance: 80 miles per hour with ¼" of ice. • Overall assembled length: varies with frequency, i.e., 297" for 530 kHz, 129" for 1710 kHz. • Accessories: Split-type mounts with stainless-steel hardware kit; masts, stands; lightning arrestors; enclosures, groundplanes, guying kits. • RF exposure separation: 1-meter minimum recommended.
